CHILDREN'S SUNDAY SCHOOL

Classes are available for all ages and each level will be studying and memorizing the same scripture in the Bible each week. We are beginning a three year sequence of going through the entire Bible in order to lay a solid foundation built on truth! Your children will love Sunday School & we are looking forward to an exciting year in the Word of God!

After musical worship during our 11am service, children are dismissed to "Kids Own Worship", a fun filled children's church designed just for them. We provide nursery care for ages 0-1, a preschool worship program, and the primary Kids Own Worship program for grades K-5. Our children's ministry is led by Jessica Morneault.

HIGH SCHOOL

Book of Revelation – A verse by verse study of this most misunderstood book. Emphasis is placed upon our readiness for the return of Christ and how we need to be changed from the inside out in order to discern the times and seasons we are living in today. A great deal of time is spent on being sure our lives reflect His presence. Led by Brian Joubert.

ELECTIVE CLASSES

Several short term, topical elective classes are available to any age who desires to attend. Our short term elective class list & schedule for the Fall of 2016 is:

Relational & Revolutionary Prayer – The emphasis of this class is on praying scripture and knowing what our position is in Christ. Relational Prayer - the personal constant prayer all day long of the Christian and Revolutionary Prayer - praying for people, revival, praying for people in distress, etc, will be taught and discussed. Danni Lichanec will lead this five week course which begins September 11th.

Our Identity in Christ:

Who We Really Are - This class will explore what it means to find our true identity: Who we really are in Christ. Using the book of Ephesians and other Scripture, we will begin to look at how Christ views us, and identify wrong ways of seeing ourselves. Topics will include our unique design, spiritual adoption, old life vs. new life, and righteousness. Hillary Schneider will lead this eight week course beginning September 18th.

Marriage Class – Marriages are under attack in the world today. Good communication is a key ingredient to a strong, successful marriage in Christ. Eric and Kristi Hoover will discuss this in a five week course beginning October 16th.

Christian Working Principles - This class will focus on Biblical principles that guide us in our careers and working experience. These can transfer to any aspect of life but will primarily focus on being a Christian in the work place. Chris Vanscoy will lead this eight week class beginning on November 20th.

Being What You've Become: Life in the Son

– The great need of the Christian is to "be" what he has "become" - a true follower of Christ. "Becoming" a Christian is what happens at the altar of prayer or the place of repentance, but "being" a Christian is what takes place on the street of living. This course focuses on the inner core state of the Christian in Christ. Starting November 20th, a DVD presentation by Steven Manley will be followed by discussion and prayer each week led by Andy Timmons. This class will run approximately 24 weeks. This is a Cross Style School of Practical Ministry course.

We also offer longer term Bible Study classes available to anyone who desires to attend a more in depth class with greater time for discussion and learning.

Poverty: Ways to Protect against This Prowler - In 1964 President Johnson declared War on Poverty with this ambitious goal, "Our aim is not only to relieve the symptoms of poverty, but to cure it and, above all, to prevent it." There has been some success — poverty in the U.S. has shrunk from 26% in 1967 to 14.8% in 2015. Yet, poverty persists. Why? What am I, as a follower of Jesus, to do about the poor? This discussion-style class will probe questions like this and search the Scriptures for answers and be led by our long term Associate Pastor, Dennis Gladden. Begins September 11th.

Hebrews: The Superior Wonder of Jesus Christ - Knowing Jesus as Savior ensures one of eternal life. Understanding the superiority of Christ guarantees His saints holy life. Mike Perry will lead this class and teach us how to prosper emotionally and spiritually.
